It has been a real pleasure to welcome everyone back to school for the spring term. In our assembly on Monday we focussed on the importance of being kind and how using positive words can brighten up someone's day. It has been so pleasing to see the children reflecting on the assembly and their random acts of kindness around the school.

The children and staff have settled well after the Christmas break and staff are hard at work driving up standards. The quality of work being produced in the classes is excellent. I very much hope that 2019 will be a very successful year for everyone associated with our school.

Attendance

Our attendance for the autumn term was 96.11% which is above our target (95.8%) for the current academic year. I am grateful to parents for ensuring that pupils are at school to learn. Naturally events such as illness means that there are times when children need to be absent from school.

I will be asking Mr Hampshire to arrange meetings with the parents of those pupils with the lowest attendance levels to see if there is anymore that we can do to ensure that the children are at school. We are always happy to help in any way we can.

Pupils only have 190 school days each academic year. Each is precious and contributes to the education of the child. We can't raise literacy and numeracy standards if the children are not here.

On the back of the cheque please write a breakdown of the children's names, classes and monetary amount for each child.
