To enhance their learning, the schools across the Academy will visit the Thinktank and take part in a "Cauldron Chemistry" session.

During this day, children will have the opportunity to tour the Thinktank Science Museum and gardens as well as taking part in a science session, delivered by the Thinktank team. This will be an exciting opportunity for your child to experience and will enrich their learning immensely.

Our school is committed to providing additional learning opportunities for your child, which extend their understanding of the curriculum being taught. The children will be travelling to The Thinktank by coach. Children will need to be in school for 8.45 ready to depart for 9.00am and will return to school at 3:30pm. The children will need to wear their school uniform and sensible shoes. They will also need a coat for the museum gardens. All children will need to bring in a packed lunch and drink from home for the day (please no glass bottles).
