Uniform	Remember that ties are a compulsory part of the uniform and that your child should wear them at all times unless given permission otherwise. Water bottles	We strongly recommend your child brings in a water bottle which is clearly labelled with their name. Water bottles will be kept in the classroom and need to be taken home each evening to be refilled. Staying hydrated will raise the children's alertness and focus.

Reading Diaries



Please ensure that your child's reading diary is in school every day. The children are encouraged to read at least five times a week at home and will need their diary signed by an adult to let us know how they are getting on. The children are responsible for changing their own books, when necessary, but this will be checked. Note that your child does not have to read a whole book a night, it is acceptable to read just a few pages, especially as the books get trickier. If they read 5 times in a week and it is signed by a family member, they will be entered into a competition - 5 times reader - with the possibility of winning a book of their choice.

Your child will be expected to learn 10 spellings at school and practise them at home each week. Please support your child to learn them. Spelling tests will take place on a Tuesday.

Your child will have their login details in their reading diary.

PE Kit

The children will need to come to school in their PE kits on a Tuesday and Friday. Please ensure that they are wearing the correct school kit.


