**Year 3 and 4 Egyptian Enrichment Day - 12th October 2022**

We are delighted to inform you that your child has the opportunity to take part in an Egyptian Enrichment Day. As part of our history curriculum, Year's 3 and 4 within three schools of the Academy, will come together at The Richard Crosse on the 12<sup>th</sup> October to take part in fun and engaging historical activities.

During this day, three special workshops will be delivered by a specialised company. This will be an exciting opportunity for your child to experience and will enrich their learning immensely. The workshops will explore how the Egyptians came to be, how upper and lower Egypt became one and why they came to live by the Nile. Also, on the day we will cover subjects such as the Pharaohs, Gods, Pyramids, food and drink, skills they had, the things they left behind, the impact they had on our world today and the process of mummification. Your child will also be provided with a 'plastic' cubic measure which they get to keep.

The school is committed to providing additional learning opportunities for your child, which extend their understanding of the curriculum being taught. As such, this activity is linked to the curriculum, but is not a part of it, and the school has received no funding for it. Therefore, it is necessary to ask for a voluntary contribution of £6.00 per pupil which should be paid via ParentPay. There is no obligation to contribute, and no pupil will be omitted from the activity because they do not pay, or do not pay in full. However, the activity cannot go ahead if the school has not received sufficient parental contributions by Monday 3rd October.
