Just a little reminder and additional information for the start of the new term.

Start and Finish Times

Nursery and Reception will continue to enter through the front gate arriving at 8.30am. Reception children will need to be collected at 3:20pm and Nursery children to be collected at 3:30pm. Here, they will be greeted and dismissed by Class 1 staff.

Key Stage One will continue to go through the front gate, going straight into their classroom via the white door, arriving at 8:30am and finishing at 3:20pm

Key Stage Two will continue to enter and leave by the front playground door, arriving at 8:30am and finishing at 3:30pm. I would like to ask all parents who are collecting to please come onto the playground to wait for children to avoid congestion on the pavement outside of school which can become unsafe for children walking home.
