

supermarket	A place where you buy groceries and other items. They are usually very large with parking space.

map symbol	A small picture on a map to tell you about something. There are symbols for schools, churches, post offices and pubs.	<input type="checkbox"/> There are many signs on the roads to help drivers use the highway code properly. address	Locates exactly where someone lives by having the house or flat number, street and town names.	<input type="checkbox"/> London is our capital city and has a population of more than 8 million.		
post code	This locates exactly where a street or a place is by using letters and numbers.	<input type="checkbox"/> Your address has the name of the street you live in, the number or name of your house; the village, town or city you live in and a post code.		
urban	A busy locations which has lots of houses and usually shops and offices.	<input type="checkbox"/> London is the capital of England; Cardiff the capital of Wales, Edinburgh the capital of Scotland and Belfast the capital of Northern Ireland.		
rural	It is a location in the country. It is not usually as busy as an urban place.	<input type="checkbox"/> One of the oldest parliaments in the world is situated in London and is called the Houses of Parliament.
