Dear Parents /Carers,

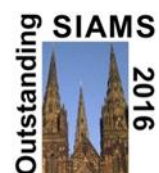

Collection of Resource Packs

Teachers have been working really hard today to put together packs for all the resources your child/ren should require up to February half term (hopefully)! These packs will be available for collection on the Crawley Lane car park playground between **3:00pm and 5:00pm today** and from **8:00am until 8:30am tomorrow morning**. Packs will be placed in family groups on tables in alphabetical order. When collecting the packs, we need to keep contact to a bare minimum therefore we would really appreciate the wearing of masks and once you have collected your packs, please leave the school site as soon as possible.

Online Learning

As with all things in this situation procedures may change according to need. Starting from tomorrow each child's teacher will provide the live input for the start of lessons (please note that early years will only have two sessions). The timetable has been devised so that sibling groups do not clash to try and relieve the pressure on IT within the home environment. Alongside the live lessons teachers will be contactable throughout school hours via the meeting link on their Google Classroom page (the meet link can be found at the top of your child's Google Classroom page). Please note that as usual school will close at 1:30pm on a Friday. Please ensure that the learning environment is conducive to school learning and in a quiet place where possible. During school sessions we ask that children be dressed and not in pyjamas not eating and ready for learning as they would be in school. Please see table below for your child/ren's session times:-
