<u>Class 3 Temporary Route into School - September 2020</u>

- If parents and children are crossing Lichfield road they should continue as they currently do, to use the Pelican crossing and enter Crawley Lane.
- Again, as children currently do, cross Crawley Lane onto the school side.
- Children should then follow the path around on the school side of the Lichfield Road onto the car park.
- Cones will be placed across the car park entrance so that cars cannot enter.
- A staff member will wear a high visibility jacket and stand on the corner of Crawley Lane and Lichfield Road.
