She stood and looked. It was the Big Brown Wolf!

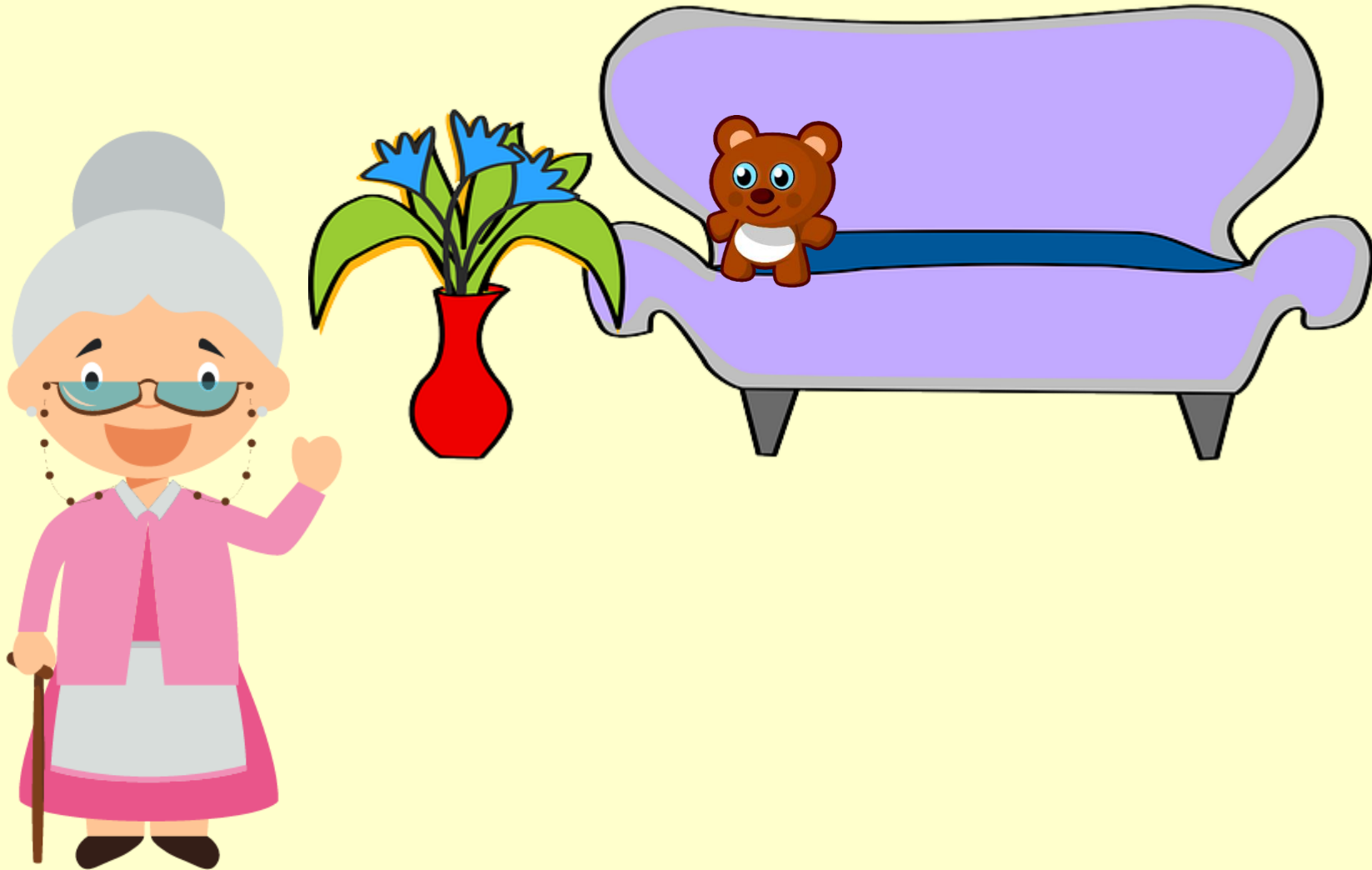


She took the short cut!
