The Richard Crosse Local Governing Committee (LGC)

A note from our Chair of Governors - Darren Walsh

The Local Governing Committee (LGC) was established recently as part of the governance arrangements for the school. The key functions are:

- Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction
- Holding the headteacher to account for educational performance
- Ensuring proper and effective use of the school's financial resources

To achieve this the LGC meet once each term. The LGC is comprised of parent, foundation and lay governors, who possess a range of skills and experience in both the public and private sector. This experience is used to discharge the key functions of the LGC.

So, what does this look like in practice? You will no doubt be aware of and are experiencing the challenges of rising food and energy prices. These issues also impact upon the school and its budget. As an LGC, we look at how the school is coping with these challenges and work with the Headteacher and the Trust to ensure that the budget forecast has considered these challenges and that a balanced budget is achieved. This is really challenging at present as the costs linked to food and energy have not decreased. The School and Trust have some reserves, which mitigate some of this impact, however, the reserves can only be used once. It is also these reserves and efficiencies that would be required to fund other expenditure that is not covered in the education grant – such as pay rises and maintenance work of the School's buildings.

The role of the LGC is both challenging and rewarding, if you are interested in becoming a member of the LGC then please contact the school office for further information.

Attendance

At the end of Spring term our whole school attendance figure was 96.63% this is better than national level of 93.6%. We really appreciate all of the



support you give us in getting your children to school on time. With being such a small school, it does not take many pupils to have the odd couple of days' absence for the percentage to quickly go up.

Government departments track school attendance figures. It is considered that attendance of 90% or below is persistent absence which will be closely monitored by school staff. Failing to improve on this 90% can lead to prosecution, which school want to help families avoid.

It only takes 19 school days off in the academic year for your child to fall into the persistently absent category. This equates to 95 hours of lost lessons.




