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## Our Learning for Term 1

We will be starting the first week back with our art and creative writing 'Take One Picture' project. This is a great immersion focus for our children, and we look forward to looking at Henri Rousseau's life and painting of 'Tiger in Tropical Storm' in more depth.

We will be using a key text / book to support our learning all the way from Nursery up to Year 6. We will choose a book every term and for some of our younger year groups may have two or three books that they will focus on. The books that we have carefully selected also supplement our topics well, so that children are able to really engross themselves into their topic.

We are very proud of our curriculum design at Rodbourne Cheney Primary, and we are all passionate about deep and rich learning in all subjects and more. Each term across the school, we will have a history or geography focus.

Term 1, we will be focusing on History (KS1 upwards).

Our children will be able to look at their chosen book in-depth and explore the language and themes within it. We hope that the children will enjoy their carefully selected books as much as we have planning them! Here is a list of the children's books and topics:
