

Class Newsletter: Year 4 Buzzard Class Term 2




Dear Parents and Carers,

Firstly, I would like to take this opportunity to say a huge well done to the children for a fantastic first term and demonstrating excellent attitudes to learning. I am excited to welcome them back in Term 2.

The children completed a range of wonderful learning across all subjects. In English, we loved our class text 'Odd and the Frost Giants' and the children completed super stories before completing a non-chronological report on the Viking Gods. The children learned a lot about the Vikings including where they came from, what they believed and how they punished those who committed crimes. In Art, the children developed their sketching skills and created a finished collage piece based on Matisse's 'Painting with Scissors'. In Science, we focused on states of matter, and lots of time in Maths was devoted to place value and geometry. A range of super learning also took place across many other subjects.

To see what learning we will be completing in Term 2, you will receive a Topic Web alongside this letter. Our two class texts will be 'The Firework-maker's Daughter' and 'The Little Match Girl'. The latter is our choice for Christmas.







Our Values this term are 'Equality' and 'Hope'. As always, we will also continue to make sure our three school rules of 'Be Safe, Be Kind, Be Respectful' are upheld.

Thank you for your support with the children's home learning in Term 1. Home Learning, will continue to be set each **Monday**, to be handed in and marked the following **Monday**. It will be based on prior learning and used as a way of consolidating what the children have already been taught, including weekly spellings and their times tables. It remains our expectation that the children read regularly at home and record what they read in their Reading Records (five times a week in total, twice to an adult); thank you again for your support with this.

PE will continue to be taught on **Mondays** and **Fridays.** Children should continue to come into school in their PE kits on these days. Children should wear PE uniform only (Blue/ Black Tracksuit Bottoms or Shorts, White PE Top, Blue or Black PE Track-Top or School Jumper, Trainers). We will aim to be outside as much as possible so ensuring the children have suitable layers is vitally important. Mondays this term will be our session with STFC.

Children will also need to bring in a refillable water bottle each day. Unfortunately, we are unable to use water fountains but our class has a drinking water tap for the children to use when needed.

Finally, another huge well done to the children for such a super start to the school year. I am very much looking forward to another super term ahead.
