City	A city is a larger town.

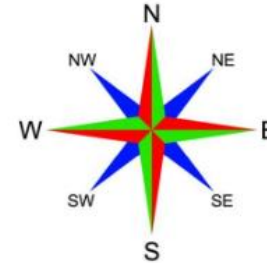

The United Kingdom (UK)

China



Population: more than 1.4 billion people live in China (2021). The majority of the people live in cities and towns.

Capital: Beijing with 21 million inhabitants is not only China's capital city but also the second biggest city after Shanghai.

Name: People's Republic of China (PRC)

Government: Republic, communist state
Languages: Mandarin or Standard Chinese (official language), while Cantonese (Yue) and Shanghaiese (Wu) are among other most spoken language.

Literacy: More than 96% can read and write.
