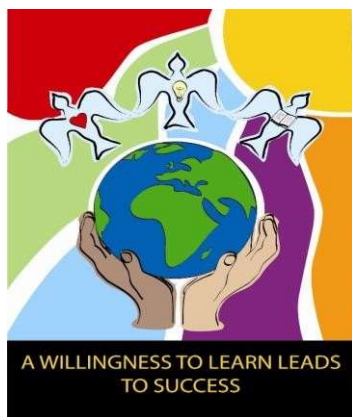


Teddy's Rodbourne Cheney Adventure

Teddy met the teachers. They were all so kind and caring.



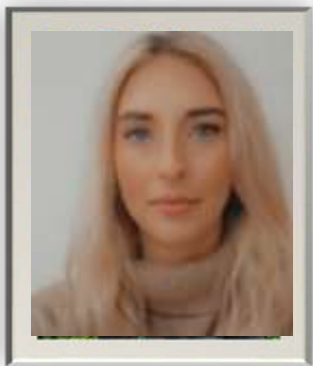

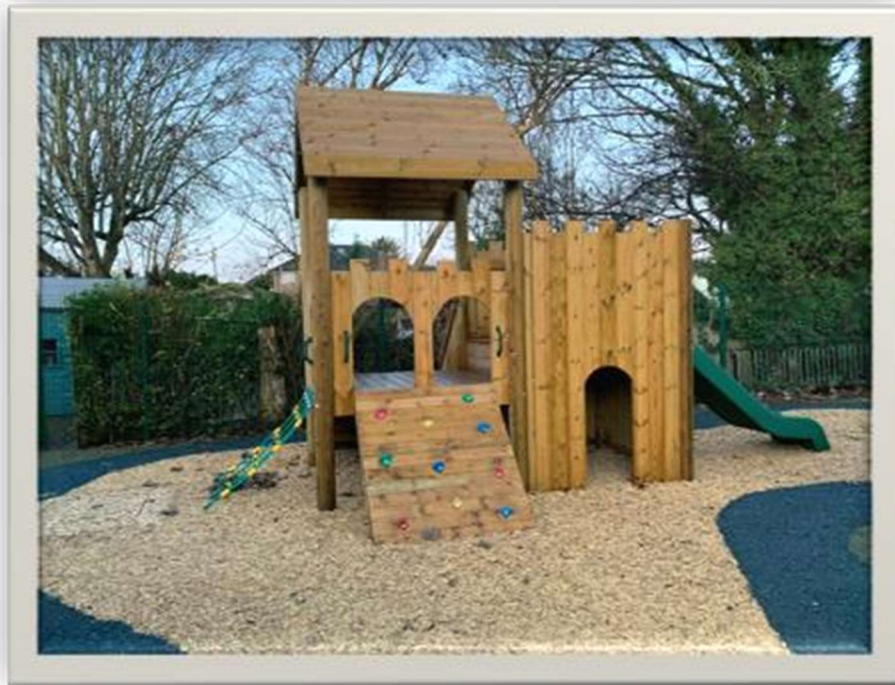
Teddy was having such a great time! Then it was snack time.
