Maths

This term in maths, we will be looking at statistics, with a particular focus on tables, tally charts, pictograms and block diagrams. We will also be looking at capacity, including measuring in litres, millilitres and measuring the temperature. We will also be recapping skills learnt throughout the year.

Science

In science this term, we will be recapping our knowledge and understanding of everyday materials and plants. While recapping these topics, we will be conducting more experiments.

English

This term in English, our class text is 'The Owl Tree' written by Jenny Nimmo. Our fiction outcome this term is: a narrative of the story, changing a character's name. Our non-fiction outcome this term is: a persuasive letter to Mr Rock asking him not to cut the owl tree down. The skills we will be recapping are: co-ordinating conjunctions, subordinating conjunctions, question sentences and expanded noun phrases. Some of the new skills we will be learning are based around different Alan Peat sentences: List sentences, similes and 2A sentences. We will also be learning about fronted adverbials, particularly those based on time and place.

Geography

This term in geography, we are looking at all creatures great and small. We will be exploring different animals native to the 7 continents and 5 oceans of the world.
