


Class Newsletter: Year 3 Penguins


Welcome back to Term 4!

This term our topic is 'Author Study – Beatrix Potter'. We will continue with our book-based curriculum. We will be reading:









Here are some book recommendations to help with learning at school this term:



Maths Learning

We will begin to look at using the column method for Addition and Subtractions. We will then move onto multiplication and division, where we will times and divide using 2-digit numbers. Finally, we will move onto, which will involve adding and subtracting amounts.

English Learning

This term in English we will be basing our writing on a selection of Beatrix Potter tales including Peter Rabbit and Jemima Puddleduck. We will be writing instructions and our own stories of when Jemima came to Rodbourne Cheney. We will also look at characterisation of character and settings.

<u>Values</u>

This term we will be focusing on the values, Love and Appreciation and this will continue to link into our whole school Values ethos and our 3 school rules. These are; Be safe, be kind, be respectful. We will use on these rules to enable us to keep safe around school, with our peers and the adults around the school.

Reading Books and Home Learning

Home Learning, will continue in Term 3 and it will be set each Monday, to be handed in and marked on the Friday. It will be based on prior learning and used as a way of consolidating what the children have already been taught, including weekly spellings and should practice their times tables at home. It remains our expectation that the children read regularly at home and record what they read in their Reading Records; thank you again for your support with this.
