

Maths

Our skills will be as follows:

- Number and Place Value: recognise, represent and read four-digit numbers, number lines, count in 25s, count in 1000s from a given number, find 1000 more and less, compare and order 4-digit numbers, rounding numbers, negative numbers, Roman Numerals.
- Multiplication and Division: times tables, multiplying by 0 and 1, dividing by 1.

Science

Our Science topic this term is States of Matter. We will be investigating solids, liquids, and gases; investigating their properties and how they change state. We will also be learning how to record our findings and set be fair tests.

English

We will start our English by examining the poem 'Sound Collector' by Roger McGough, writing a class version of the poem. Our class text for writing will be 'The Great Kapok Tree'. We will use adjectives and expanded noun phrases to write diary entries and setting descriptions. We will use video inspiration 'Taking Flight' to write non-fiction texts including a letter. Our class text for reading will be extracts from 'Varjak Paw,' 'Cats,' and 'Big Cats'. This will allow us to develop our skills in fluency, retrieval, and inference.

History

We will explore the themes surrounding our class text 'Odd and the Frost Giants,' Norse Gods and their myths and the way the Vikings lived and influenced Britain.
