

Maths

Our skills will be as follows:

- Addition and subtraction: mental strategies, adding and subtracting thousands, adding and subtracting hundreds, adding and subtracting tens, adding and subtracting ones, rounding and compensating, counting to find the difference.
- Geometry: learning the different triangles and quadrilaterals.

Science

Our science topic this term is Sound. We will be investigating how sounds are made and how they travel. We will also be learning how to carry out investigations and record our findings.

English

For reading, our class text will be 'The Firework-maker's Daughter,' Asia and Volcanoes. For writing, we will be reading 'The Barnabus Project' and using an animation called 'The Gift.' During English we will be revising and learning grammatical terms including conjunctions, adverbs, prepositions, expanded noun phrases, paragraphs and present tense verbs. We will be writing a character description and letter.

Geography

In geography, we will be learning about Asia, particularly Thailand. We will explore human and physical features and climate then compare this geographical information to Europe and the UK.
