

Maths

In Maths our skills for Term 3 will be as follows:

- Multiplication and division (Using formal methods to multiply and divide numbers with up to 4 digits as well as looking at multiplying numbers mentally.).
- Position and direction (using and plotting coordinates in the first quadrant, describing and carrying out translations and describing and carrying out reflections).

Science

Our Science topic this term is 'Properties and changes of materials'. We will be learning about thermal insulators and conductors and soluble and insoluble materials. We will also set up enquiries in order to find out which materials can be separated and which materials make irreversible chemical changes. We will present our findings to answer key scientific questions. We will also visit Science Oxford and take part in a changing states workshop.

English

Our class texts in English in Term 3 will be 'The Egyptian Cinderella' and 'The Story of Tutankhamun'. During English we will be revising and learning grammatical terms including relative clauses, brackets, dashes and subordinate clauses whilst building up to text types including alternative fairy tales, biographies and more.

History

This term in history we will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians. We will be learning about what life was like for The Egyptians, how they built the pyramids, the process of mummification and the discovery of Tutankhamun.

Art

Our Art focus is texture in term 3. We will be creating our own Egyptian inspired batik art using wax.

RE

Our RE focus is the question 'How can Brahman be everywhere and in everything?'

PE

Our focus in PE this term is movement sequences. We will develop our skills in order to create a movement sequence based on Egyptian dance. We will also continue to have expert PE coaching from our dance teacher. Also this term we will be receiving coaching from a cricket coach to learn more about the sport.

PSHE

We follow JIGSAW in PSHE. Our focus for Term 3 will be 'Dreams and Goals' where we will look at different career paths and dreams and goals of people from other cultures.

Geography

This term we are studying a history based topic. We will however look at the location of Egypt on a world map.

Computing

The children will be using Scratch to program and develop games this term.

Music

The children will be learning practical and theory skills from our Music Express scheme.
