Dear Parents and Carers,


Firstly, we would like to take this opportunity to say we hope you all had a lovely and restful half term. The children worked very hard again last term and produced some fantastic work on The Ancient Egyptians. We were particularly proud of them all for their efforts and performance in the dance festival at The Wyvern. This was a wonderful way to showcase and celebrate their dance learning from the past three terms. We are excited to welcome the children back in term 4 to begin our 'The Americas' topic.

Alongside this letter, you should receive a Topic Web which will detail all curriculum information, including what will be taught in each subject over the next term. Our main class text for the term will be 'Wonder' by R.J Palacio – one of our favourites! 'The Americas' will be our second geography topic this year and you can find out more about our topic through our Knowledge Organiser which should also have been sent to you too. Our Values this term are 'Appreciation' and 'Love'.

Thank you for your support with the children's home learning in Term 3. Home Learning, chosen from the children's CGP books, will continue to be set each Monday to be handed in and marked the following Monday. It will be based on prior learning and used as a way of consolidating what the children have already been taught. Alongside this, the children will also have weekly spellings and should practise their times tables at home. It remains our expectation that the children read regularly at home and record what they read in their Reading Records; thank you again for your support with this. It is important that our children wear the correct uniform and look smart at school. Please see our school uniform below. Our school uniform is as follows:

- Blue jumper
- White or blue polo shirt (with all buttons fastened)
- Black or grey shorts

- Children are able to wear all black footwear.



PE will be taught on **Tuesday** and **Thursday** afternoons so children will need to make sure that they wear their PE kits into school on this day each week. Children should wear PE uniform only. Our school PE kit is:

- Black / blue tracksuit bottoms, leggings or shorts;
- White PE t-shirt
- Blue or black tracksuit top or school jumper.
- Trainers

Children will also need to bring in a refillable water bottle each day and we encourage them to bring in a healthy snack to eat at break time.
