

Maths

In Maths our skills for Term 4 will be as follows:

- Fractions, decimals and percentages (identifying equivalent fractions, ordering and comparing fractions with denominator multiples and knowing percentage and decimal equivalents of fractions).
- Fractions (adding and subtracting fractions with denominators that are multiples, converting between improper fractions and mixed numbers, multiplying fractions by a whole number).

Science

Our Science topic this term is 'Earth and Space'. We will be learning about the features of planets in our solar system and how they move. We will also explore the movement and phases of the moon as well researching and answering key scientific questions around Earth and Space.

English

Our class text in English in Term 4 will be 'Wonder' by R.J Palacio. During English we will be revising and learning grammatical terms including relative clauses, dialogue, modal verbs and adverbs for certainty whilst building up to text types including narratives and a persuasive speech.

Geography

This term we will be learning about The Americas. We will study their climates as well as comparing different countries in North and South America to The UK. We will also look at some of the human and physical features of The Americas.

Art

Our Art focus is pop art in term 4. We will be exploring the works of Andy Warhol and creating our own pop art pieces.

RE

Our RE focus is the question 'How significant is it for Christians to believe God intended Jesus to die?'

PE
