

Maths

In Maths our skills for Term 3 will be as follows:

- Fractions (including multiplication and division of fractions).
- Percentages (solve problems involving the calculation of percentages and the use of percentages for comparison).
- Converting units (including converting between units of times, and between miles and km),
- Area and Volume (including calculating areas of parallelograms and triangles).

Science

Our Science topic this term is Living things and their habitats. We will be describing how living things are classified according to their characteristics. We will be looking at similarities and differences between microorganisms, plants and animals. We will also be giving reasons for classifying plants and animals based on their characteristics

English

Our text this term is 'The Girl of Ink and Stars'. During English we will be revising and learning grammatical terms including noun phrases, complex sentences and the passive voice, whilst building up to writing a range of text types including myths and non-chronological reports. For the latter, the children will design a hybrid creature and use AI to bring it to life!

History

This term we are learning about The Ancient Greeks. We will be looking at Greek democracy, Gods and Goddesses and the battle between the Athenians and Spartans. As always, we will finish by creating our very own double page spreads celebrating our new History knowledge.

Art

Our Art focus is Clay. Taking inspiration from our History topic, the children will be designing and making their very own Greek pots.

RE

In RE, we will delve deep into the question, 'Is Christianity still a strong religion 2000 years after Jesus was on earth?'

PE

Our focus in PE this term is Movement Patterns. The children will learn to create and perform a short sequence linking basic actions, in order to create an expressive dance. We will explore movement sequences, showing contrast in speed, level and
