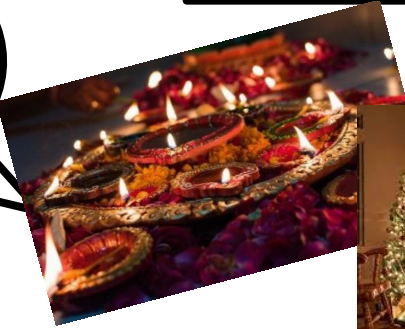


<b>Vocabulary Five!</b>

<b>Winter</b>	The coldest season of the year.

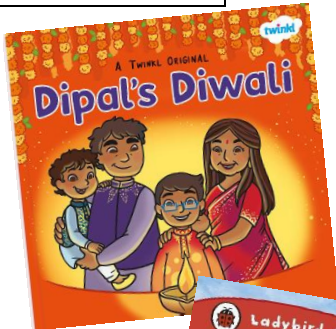
