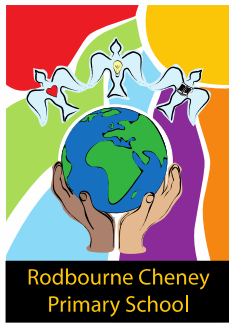

Blue hooded top (one with logo can now be purchased from school shop) or black sports jacket.

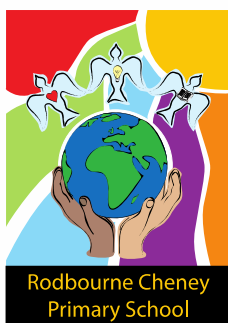
Logoed items can all be purchased from The Famous Schoolwear shop in Swindon.
