## As a school we will:

- Respect the confidentiality of information regarding each child.
- Discuss any concerns we have about your child, with you.
- Provide information to you about our school, including relevant policies, meetings, workshops, and events by keeping our website up-to-date, emailing regular updates and newsletters and providing information via text and through Seesaw (our online learning App).

## As Parents and Carers we will:

- Make sure our child attends school and arrives at school by 8:45am.
- Make sure we collect our child on time at 3.15pm each day.
- Ensure our child wears the full and correct uniform for school and has the school PE kit and footwear in school.
- Ensure our child does not wear jewellery to school, except simple stud earrings for pierced ears and that our child does not attend school with dyed/bleached hair, unless invited to.
- Inform us each day by telephone, if our child is too unwell to attend school.
- Aim for our child to have an attendance of 95% or higher.
- Let the school know of any concerns or worries that may be affecting my child's learning, behaviour or ability to do home learning, as school may be able to help.
- Support our school Vision, aims and Values-based education as found on our website.
- Communicate with school and attend meetings with my child's teacher and other staff, aiming to be positive and productive, working towards moving my child on in their learning.
