### English

In English we will be following Pathways to Write and this half term will explore myths, using the book *Beowulf* by Michael Morpurgo. The end aim is to write a further adventure for *Beowulf*.

In grammar we will use expanded noun phrases, use conjunctions to create multi clause sentences and integrate dialogue into a text.
