Dear Parents/Carers and Roose Families,

I can not believe that we are approaching July and another school year is nearly behind us! School days are so busy and go too quickly. There are only a couple of weeks left until the end of term and we have so many things to fit in!

I would like to say a huge thank you to all of Team Roose — our children, staff, governors and parents/carers for all their help and support this year. It has been a successful year at school and the staff have all worked incredibly hard to ensure that the children have the best time at school whilst accessing a fantastic learning experience.

Please read this newsletter carefully so you and your child do not miss out on any of the special events and activities taking place between now and the end of term.

Reports

Your child will receive their end of year report on Friday 14th July (Monday 17th July for year 4 pupils due to their residential). This will be a printed copy of our new format report and a copy of your child's attendance for your information. If you would like to discuss your child's report with their teacher after you have received it, please contact them via Seesaw to arrange a meeting. Thank you to staff for completing these detailed reports. I am sure you will enjoy reading them and will recognise how well the staff know your child and have enjoyed teaching them.

Assessments

Children have taken part in their summer assessments and these are being used to inform teachers of whether your child is working below, at or above the expected level for their year group. Children who have taken part in statutory assessments will also have these marks on – year 1 phonics screening test, year 2 KS1 SATs, year 4 x table check, year 6 KS2 SATs. The majority of children have made excellent progress this year and the children and staff have been working incredibly hard in lessons. We are still seeing the effects of time off during covid on our results and these do not reflect the outstanding teaching and learning which takes place at Roose. We are sure that over time, the gap will narrow and we will continue to strive for all children to achieve the best they can. Many children will regress in their learning over the summer holidays. Please help us to keep your child's learning and knowledge where it is at the moment, by doing some small activities with them over the summer e.g. continuing with reading, maths games and x tables, phonics games, BBC bitesize is great for revision and recapping. Thank you for your support with this, it will help your child to be ready to fly when they start in their new class!

Attendance and holidays during term time

We have seen an increase in holidays during term time and our attendance is still slightly under 95%. Please can we ask that holidays are booked in school holiday time and that you avoid your child being absent unless they are ill/injured or have a medical appointment. This means they don't miss valuable learning time. Thank you.
