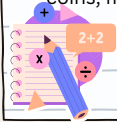


MATHS

PE

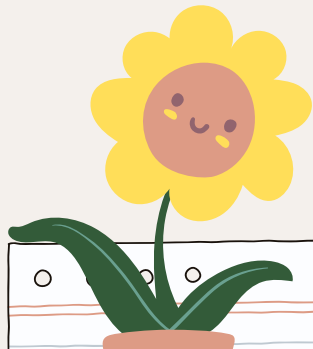
Dance - To different stories/traditional tales

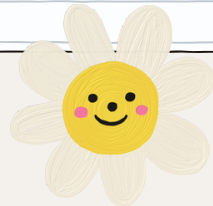
