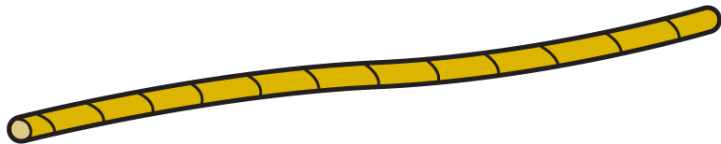

There are 5 in each bag.

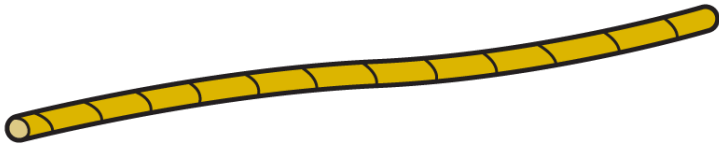


How many bags can Danny fill using all the sweets?

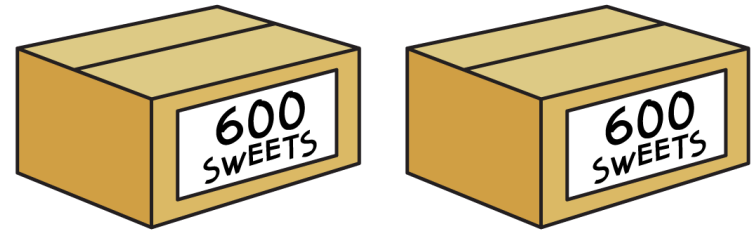
- 2 A rope measures 2.8 metres.
