Dear Parents/Carers.

Thank you for bearing with us with this ever changing situation we all find ourselves in.

As you have been informed, the key worker list has been released which has informed us which children can come in to school on Monday. Thank you for your support as we organise this. For all those who are at home, 'remote learning' will be up and running through 'Class Dojo' from Monday morning. Children will receive instructions on their daily tasks through Dojo and staff will be available during the day to offer feedback and guidance. If there are any issues, please let your child's class teacher know.

For those children who are receiving childcare from us, we expect that the majority will arrive and leave at the normal times. However, we can facilitate shorter days, should you be available at home for part of a day. We can also offer some additional hours from 8.30am until 4.00pm. Unfortunately, we are unable to offer any hours outside of these at this time. At the moment, we would ask that children use their normal door to come into school. Should children be coming in for 8.30, then please use the breakfast club door through the new gate. We may change where children come in to school as the week progresses and we adapt any plans we currently have in place. We will always keep you fully informed through Class Dojo.

Food will be provided for all children on site from Monday onwards. From Tuesday, we will also be offering a 'grab bag' packed lunch for anyone who is entitled to either a free school meal or a universal free school meal. (The latter refers to any child in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.) These meals would need to be collected from school. The system for those entitled to a free school meal will change as the government have said that they will be offering vouchers instead of schools making packed lunches. At present, there are no details on how this will work but we will send more information as we receive it. We realise that not all those entitled to a free lunch will want one and it is important that we know how many we need to prepare.
