## Inspecting primary school PE and school sport: new funding

## Background

The Primary PE and Sport Premium was launched by the Government in April 2013 and is available for 3 academic years:2013/14, 2014/15 and 2015/16. It is ring-fenced funding to be used by the school to improve the quality and breadth of our PE and sport provision.
