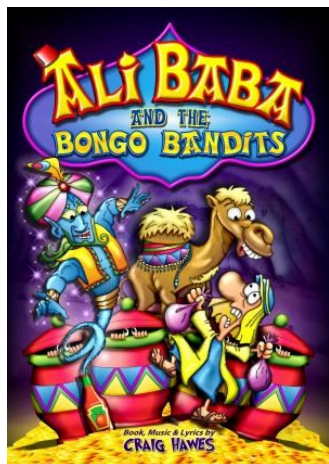





### Reports
