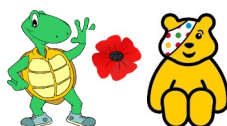


There was a near miss yesterday when a child rode his scooter very fast down the middle of the road on Roseberry Crescent. Please be careful, children!

## Attendance really does matter...




You may think that being a few minutes later for school each day, or having time off throughout the year won't affect your child's learning, but look at some statistics I found recently.

They make interesting reading!

If your child misses...	That equals...	Which is...	And over 13 years of schooling, that's...
1 day every 2 weeks	20 days per year	4 weeks per year	Nearly 1.5 years
1 day per week	40 days per year	8 weeks per year	Over 2.5 years
2 days per week	80 days per year	16 weeks per year	Over 5 years
10 mins per day (arriving late)	50 mins per week	Nearly 1.5 weeks per year	Nearly half a year
20 mins per day (arriving late)	1hr 40mins per week	Over 2.5 weeks per year	Nearly 1 year

That's a lot of learning missed!  
Missing out on learning not only affects children's progress, but knocks their self confidence, too.
