## **Thank you for your views!**

Thank you to everyone who took time to complete our recent survey. It's always good to have feedback about what you think we do well, as well as finding out what you think we may improve.

In total we had 15 responses, with the following results:

- My child is happy to be a member of the Roseberry family and feels safe = 100% agree
- Staff make sure that children are well behaved = 100% agree
- When I have raised concerns with school they have been dealt with properly = 80% agree (20% did not enter an answer)

*One person felt it is unfair when a child who has been unkind to another child is awarded Pupil of the Week soon after - this can make it seem as though they are being rewarded.*

- The school makes me aware of what my child will learn throughout the year = 100% agree
- The school has high expectations of my child = 100% agree

*Two people felt that work in school and at home was not challenging enough for their children.*

- My child does well at this school = 100% agree
- The school lets me know how well my child is doing = 93% agree

*One person stated that they were only informed if they asked for information and another stated that they only find out at Parents' Evenings.*

- There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school and the school supports my child's wider personal development = 87% agree
- My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school = 100% agree

*One person expressed disappointment that we do not have a school football team.*

- I would recommend this school to another parent = 100%
