Important news - New Attendance Policy to be implemented from Monday 27th January 2020

We all recognise that children need to attend school regularly to benefit from their education. Missing out on lessons leaves children vulnerable to falling behind and children with poor attendance tend to achieve less in both primary and secondary school. Missing out on learning, either whole lessons or part of a lesson due to lateness, can impact upon a child's confidence and self esteem as well as their progress. The government expects schools to:

- Promote good attendance and reduce absence, including persistent absence
- Ensure every pupil has access to full-time education to which they are entitled
- Act early to address patterns of absence

In addition to this, the government expects parents to perform their legal duty by ensuring their children of compulsory school age who are registered at school attend regularly and arrive on time for school.

The Enquire learning Trust has recently updated a whole Trust Attendance Policy, which can be found on our school website. It is important that parents and carers are aware of this policy, as it outlines expectations regarding attendance and the measures that will be taken from now on should parents fail to ensure their children attend school regularly.
