NURSERY UPDATE

All being well, subject to Local Authority agreement following our consultation period, we are hoping that our nursery should be open in January 2021, earlier than originally planned!

We would like our provision to be open from 8.30am - 3pm Monday to Friday to welcome 3 year olds with 30 hours funding. We also hope to be able to offer places to 2 year olds with the option of parents topping up their 15 funded hours (if criteria for funding is met) to 30 hours.

We are finalising our admissions policy at the moment and it will most likely be that places are offered on a first come, first served basis, but with priority given to children eligible for funding. There will be a waiting list in operation for children who do not have a place initially. If you'd like your child to have a place, please contact the school office as soon as possible!

We have been in contact with our uniform provider, Motif8 and they are ordering in small sweatshirts and jumpers. These will be the same as school uniform so that parents won't have to buy separate uniform when children transfer into Reception. I am currently working on costings and further, detailed, information will be issued following a Local Authority meeting to be held on 10th December. Watch this space!
