Please keep your child safe!

Did you know that in a crash at 30mph, the first instant of contact until the vehicle comes to a complete stop can occur in one-tenth of a second and that if your child is not restrained they will hit the front seat, and anyone in it, with a force between 30 and 60 times their own body weight? This could result in death or serious injury to your child and the person sitting in the front seat.

Recently, I have become increasingly concerned by reports of Roseberry children seen in the front and back seats of cars with no seatbelt or car seat evident.

This is illegal and extremely dangerous. UK law states that children must use a child car seat until they're 12 years old or 135cm/4ft 5in tall, whichever comes first. Please don't let your child become a road safety statistic. Your children are precious - please protect them.
