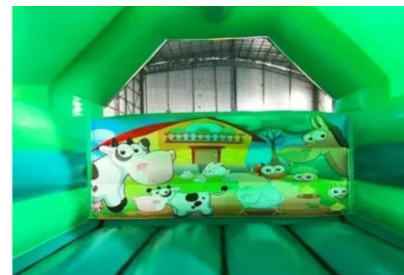
All proceeds go into our budget for little extras for our children!
