Act of Kindness

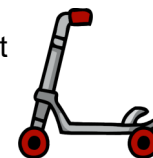
This week's award goes to Jacob McCulloch. He was happy to share the boxes he had brought in from home so that his friend could make her own Tudor house. What a star!

Lateral Flow Test or PCR test?

Government guidance states that Lateral Flow Tests are to be used for asymptomatic testing only. If the test result is negative, self isolation stops. If it is positive, you will be advised as to what to do next.
