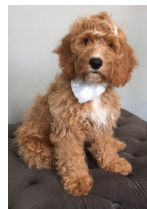

### How safe is your child online?

Do you know what your child is doing online? Do you know who they are speaking to and who their online 'friends' are? Have you checked the content of the online games they play? Are they able to access the internet whilst you are asleep?

### Why is punctuality and attendance so important?

Have you ever been late for an appointment or a meeting and had to enter a room full of people who are already settled and know what's going on? It can feel really uncomfortable. This is how children feel when they arrive late for school. Please remember that school starts at 8.55am.

It's also vitally important that children come to school every day, unless they really are too poorly to attend. Being absent from school can impact upon children's self esteem and confidence, as they often struggle to catch up with lost learning. They also miss out on the conversations that their friends have had and this can lead to them feeling left out when they return. School is fun - let's get children in every day!

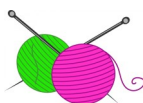
