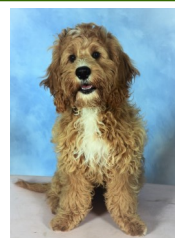

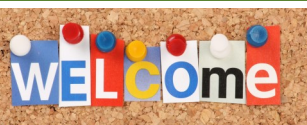
School photographs!

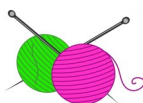

My Child At School
