order needs to be placed for the number of


lunches ordered and we need to do this in



#### **Headspace!**

Our Family Mentor, Lesley, does an amazing job supporting children and their families, offering advice, support, strategies for self regulation and relaxation and much more! Lesley supports many children who are able to self refer, or are referred for her support by parents or staff. Mrs Sellers has recognised a need for children to be able to share their worries when Lesley isn't available and so will be running 'Headspace' sessions, offering further support for those children who may be feeling a little wobbly. These sessions will be very informal, enabling children to talk through how they are feeling and socialise within a small group. 'Headspace' will take place in the Y2 classroom from 12-12.30pm for KS2 each Wednesday and KS1 each Friday, with teachers suggesting which children may benefit from attendance in the first instance.
