## School meals

Our school meals are scrumptious! If you would like your child to have a school meal, please book it from the menu via the My Child At School app.

If you think you may be eligible to claim free school meals, please contact the office. Even if your child is in EYFS, Y1 or Y2 and receives Universal Free School meals, it's still important that you let us know if you think you are eligible to claim, as this will enable us to access funding from the Government for your child's education.

If you pay for school meals, please do so via My Child At School. Please note that if you get into debt with payments, you will be asked to provide a packed lunch for your child until the debt is cleared.
