All aboard our RAFT!

Roseberry Academy Friends and Teachers (RAFT) is our parent and teacher association, a group of adults who are passionate about providing opportunities, experiences and resources for our children.

RAFT has worked tirelessly over the years to raise money to provide such things as: books for the library, playtime and sports equipment (including goal posts and netball posts) and playground markings, the HUGE pirate ship on the lower playground, Boogie Bounce trampettes and online learning packages for every child in school to access. It has also helped to fund a travelling pantomime as well as coach travel for Year Six children's residential visit to East Barnby. Every year, RAFT sets aside money for an Enrichment Fund, which is used to pay towards school visits and enrichment activities so that parents aren't continually asked to make voluntary contributions - something we know is difficult for them to do during a cost of living crisis.

When children join our school family, their parents and guardians automatically become members of RAFT. They are not obliged to do anything, or attend meetings but they are most welcome and positively encouraged to do so! RAFT meetings are never cliquey or overly formal - they are light hearted get togethers where adults plan how they can raise money through fun activities to provide the special extras that the school's budget cannot fund.

Monday 2nd October at 7pm.
