Builders have been into school this week to dig holes in the lower school hall and corridor floors to enable plumbers to access the leaking pipework. The problem we are faced with is that the leaking pipes are old and corroded and plumbers need to find the best way of repairing or replacing them so that the solution to our heating problem lasts. All of the pipework is underneath concrete floors and so the project could prove to be extensive. The work will be carried out as quickly as possible to ensure that the lower school has heating once more and that our displaced children may return to their classrooms. In the meantime, we are grateful to Stokesley Primary Academy for letting us use their vacant classrooms and spare playground for our infant children.
