Some of the concerns raised were as follows:

The parking situation puts children at risk - I'm as worried as you, but still have not managed to persuade the council to address this and have no powers to challenge drivers. It's up to every parent to park with care!

Enrichment experiences seem to be limited - we are addressing this with the development of our new curriculum in September.

We don't like the poetry homework and feel homework completed should be celebrated! We're looking into changes!

Should children who misbehave miss physical time at playtime? This sanction works - children don't like to miss their playtimes.

We need to know what our children need to bring to school before the school year starts —I'll ask teachers to let their children know during transition.

Parental views aren't sought often enough and the survey limited our responses - It was a free survey, so was limiting! We have an open door policy should you wish to share your thoughts throughout the year, though.

Thank you to the volunteers who supervised Year Three children on their visit to the Captain Cook memorial garden and exhibition last Friday.
