Two responses showed that parents were very concerned about food and treats in school not always being healthy. As a result of this, prize tins in school do not contain sweets and I have spoken to the RAFT committee about providing a healthy treat option instead of Haribo. Parents at the RAFT meeting felt that, for some children, sweets at RAFT events are a rare treat and so it was agreed that a healthy option will be provided in addition to sweets. I have also checked the menu generated by our school meals provider to ensure that our menu is as healthy as can be all of the time, as a concern was raised regarding the frequency of burger and tomato sauce being served. I hope that these changes will further encourage our children to be healthy!
