THIS WEEK IN SCHOOL

It has been a great 8 days for me here as new Headteacher. I have already started to meet many of our families and have received a very positive warm welcome, thank you.

We have spent time reviewing our approach to behaviour during our first few training days. All of our staff have been really creative in putting up a recognition board in their classroom. A focus for us is to recognise the learning behaviours we do want to see rather than a focus on the behaviour we don't. I must say the behaviour of all children in around school has been very good. I know we will be able to focus on raising standards and aspiration for all our children because of positive attitude to learning. I very much look forward to sharing with you our progress over the coming year.

START OF DAY AND END OF DAY

Welcome to our new families and children. The children in Nursery and Reception have settled really well.

We are aiming for a prompt start to the school day, ready for learning to start at 9am. We have opened the doors at 8.45am. Children should arrive to school for 8.45am and go straight up to their classes. Lessons start at 9am and any children arriving after this time will need to go to the general office where they will be marked late and will receive a late slip. At the end of the day children will need to be collected by an adult. Older siblings must be at least 14 and have had the prior consent of the parent to take their sibling home alone.

DINNER MONEY

Please ensure you keep your account up to date. If your account exceeds £23 arrears you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch.

MOBILE PHONES

We do not allow children to bring mobile phones into school. If you feel that it is necessary for your child to bring a phone to school you will be required to make an appointment with Mrs Williams, the Headteacher.

PARKING

Thank you for all those families that are considering the safety of our children and parking safely away from the school gate. I must remind families not to double-park or park in front of our residents drive ways or obstruct the view of children crossing the road. We are in talks with the council to support us with traffic and parking. In particular we have requested the ice-cream van does not park outside our school gates. Please support us with this venture. I want reduce the air pollution this creates at the entrance to our school, support families that feel pressured to purchase an ice-cream daily for their children. Most importantly, the children are able to cross with a full view of the road ahead.
