

Investigating Averages

 $\boldsymbol{q}_{\text{n}}$ 6U this week we have learnt about investigating averages, (Mean, Median, Mode and Range). It was very interesting and challenging.



First, we got in groups of five . Then, we recorded our shoe sizes in our early morning books and the average size for our class was 5 - 6 . Next, we got our measuring tape and measured our hand span; they were all different sizes . After that, we moved onto our arm lengths. It was fascinating knowing that the measurements were different from what we had estimated. We received

feedback from our classmates and they seemed to really enjoy it.

Later on, we measured our head circumference in centimetres , which was quite easy to do. The average was about 50 or above . We were very enthusiastic about doing this as we all were excited to find out our heads span. However this took us all quite a while to calculate everyone's measurements in the group. We all enjoyed it.



Although this all took quite a while we agreed that it was worth the time . All the measurements that we had taken we had to be sure of , so that when we transferred them to mode , median , mean and range they were correct . Once we calculated the mode, median, mean and range we were all set for the next lesson self-reflection on our learning.
