FREE SCHOOL MEALS DURING HOLIDAY PERIODS

Lewisham has received an allocation of Winter Covid Funding to support people facing hardship, with particular emphasis on children and families.

Lewisham have agreed to use some of this grant to fund Free School Meals for eligible children (not universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) unless they have FSM eligibility in as well) during the next three school holiday periods (i.e. Christmas 2020, February half term 2021 and Easter 2021). Support is to continue at £15 per week per child as before.


